Something to Think About

The cross of Jesus Christ stands as the dividing line between despair and hope, between emptiness and assurance, between darkness and everlasting life.

Points to Ponder

- If there is no resurrection, then Christianity collapses into sorrow dressed in religion.
- Because of the cross, the grave is not the end of the story. It is a passage into the presence of God.
- The child of God can walk through the valley of the shadow of death knowing that Jesus Christ already walked through it first and came out victorious on the other side.
- Without the cross, life becomes nothing more than a short journey from dust to dust. But because of it, life becomes preparation for eternity.
- A sinner has no ability to justify himself before God.
- There is a difference between religion and justification by faith. Religion says, "hold tighter." Jesus says, "It is finished." Religion says, "try harder." Jesus says, "You're justified freely by my grace."
